Those documents are the source of the answers to questions that frequently come up, and form the authority for all compliance obligations for which each of us as shareholders is responsible, and by which all enforcement is undertaken by the manager, the ESC board and the ESC attorney. The harmony of our community is best found in the respect and consideration we have for each other.

With respect to a shareholders sale of his/her share and unit, all sales are subject to approval by the ESC board of directors. Last season, two shareholders entered into sales agreements without first submitting the required application to the office. There came a point when the paperwork was finally received that the proposed buyers were not approved based on the legal opinion of the ESC attorney. Needless to say, this caused the sellers some inconvenience, and left them needing to find new buyers. Just because a shareholder finds someone willing to buy their unit, ESC is NOT obligated to approve that purchase. If you find a buyer, submit the required paperwork FIRST to the ESC office so that the approval process can be completed. You may save yourself some anguish.

It is the "holiday" season. We all have our traditions and there are few of us that do not find this time of the year "special".

With that in mind, may I wish each of you a memorable Christmas season that allows you time to reflect all that is special to you at this time of the year.

Understanding the meaning of the Designation of Voting Member Form that was sent out with the First Mailing of the 2018 Annual Meeting.....

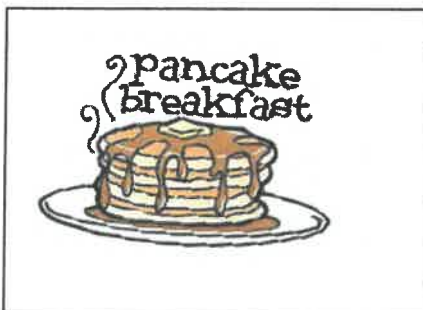
A Voting Certificate Form should be on file in the association records from each **jointly-owned** and each **corporate owned unit** in the Community and a roster of designated voters should be maintained by the Association Secretary.

The **joint ownership by husband and wife should not be overlooked** and a designation should be made by them as well. When selecting an individual to be the designated voter, it is advisable to select one of the owners of the unit. The voting certificate remains valid until the owners wish to change the designated person or until the unit is sold.

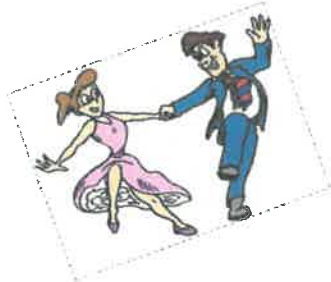
