Just a few updates this month. First, the 2021 Annual meeting will be Friday, February 12th. The Board of Directors have put some requirements in place to assure the safety of those Shareholder who will be attending the meeting in person.

- The Clubhouse doors will open at 9:20.

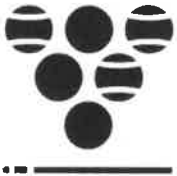

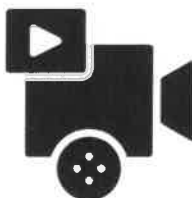
